

Recognition and Accreditation

Murdoch University Dubai, licenced by Knowledge and Human Development Authority (KHDA), is also regulated from Australia by the national quality assurance and regulatory agency for higher education, Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency (TEQSA).

This double government-level oversight assures you of the highest quality international education. We offer the exact same Australian course content here in Dubai because we believe in our core purpose of providing an exceptional, international educational experience to students in the region. Our campus in the UAE ensures that students who are unable to travel internationally for their education still have the opportunity to earn a high-quality, Australian-accredited internationally recognised degree.

Our Dubai campus achieved a 91.1% student satisfaction rate and a 92.4% satisfaction rate with teaching and learning, exceeding the industry benchmark of 60-80%. Additionally, our campus received a perfect score of 50/50 points for Career Support provided to our students.

All courses follow the same academic requirements as the courses offered in Australia, and are taught by highly qualified international lecturers. The degrees awarded are issued from Australia and are exactly the same as the ones conferred on campus in Australia. We have three intakes a year - January, May, and September - to offer you the flexibility to join our wide range of courses.

Our Dubai campus is merely 10 minutes away from thriving Dubai business hubs and districts such as Internet City, Media City, Palm Jumeirah and Dubai Marina. Students have access to our vibrant campus situated in the heart of innovative business-focused communities that are home to some of the world's largest Fortune 500 companies.

Students at Murdoch University Dubai enjoy a variety of extracurricular activities, ensuring a holistic approach to student welfare on campus, including sports teams, music clubs and a variety of social events.

We offer Foundation, Diploma (undergraduate first year), undergraduate and postgraduate courses in a wide range of subject areas, so you can choose a course best suited to your interests and goals*.

Our flexible structure means that you have a number of entry points available depending on your academic and English language qualifications.


Our undergraduate courses also provide the option to study two majors at one time, to broaden your qualifications and choice of careers.

Throughout the next section of this guide, explore the key topics that will be covered in each major, find out about course requirements and discover careers that you could pursue.

Courses

The Foundation Studies program is undertaken over three trimesters, with the option of fast-tracking in two trimesters. The fast-track duration for an undergraduate course at Murdoch University Dubai is two years, based on three trimesters of full-time study per year. Alternatively, you can choose to complete your course in the standard three years.

If your academic or English language qualifications do not allow for direct entry into Year 1 of an undergraduate degree program, you may be eligible for entry into a Diploma course. The Diploma is equivalent to Year 1 of the standard undergraduate degree.





For postgraduate courses, a Graduate Certificate can be completed in 1 trimester (full-time study) and the full Master's degree can be completed in 1 year (3 trimesters of full-time study). Students may also choose to study part-time and complete the course over a longer duration, based on their study load.

Should you not meet the entry requirements for direct entry into a Master's degree, you may be eligible to start with a Graduate Certificate, which is equivalent to one trimester of the Master's degree.

Choosing What to Study

When choosing what to study at university, you have a wide range of options. Regardless of what degree or course combinations you choose, we can help you develop a wide range of practical and transferable skills, including critical and creative thinking, communication, research and problemsolving skills.

If you're unsure about what you want to do, that's okay! Here are a few things to think about...

Talk to people

Find out as much as you can about different subjects, courses and careers by talking to your high school career adviser and teachers, your family and friends, and even people in jobs you think you might enjoy.

Explore more than one area

Whether you're researching university courses or are just trying to figure out what you'd like to study, don't limit yourself to one area. At Murdoch you can study a combined degree or double major, meaning you can study two completely different or complementary areas. You could study a course that will give you the qualification needed for your future career alongside something you find really interesting.

Figure out what you like, and what you don't

We all learn best when we're studying something we enjoy. So when it comes to choosing your university course, you should base your decision on exactly that. Make a list of the things you love, have a passion for, or are just really good at. You may have a subject at school that you really like or perhaps there's something you do in your free time that you could study at university and turn into a career.

Do your research

Consider the type of job you can see yourself working in

Are you better at working with people or by yourself? Do you thrive in an indoor environment or do you prefer to be outside amongst nature? Do you like the idea of travelling for work? Ask yourself these questions and even get a taste for different work environments by completing work experience while you're still in high school.

Remember, it's okay to change your mind

Try to remain flexible in the way you think about your future, because you might just change your mind! Research shows Australian professionals change their career path an average of five to seven times. If you find that the course you chose isn't really for you, or you discover something different you'd like to study instead, that's okay. Even once you've started at uni, there's still the flexibility to change.














Scholarships

Academic merit scholarship

We offer academic merit scholarships ranging from 15% to 40% of the total tuition fees based on previous academic performance*. Students must not be in receipt of any other Murdoch University Dubai scholarship and may commence their program of study in any of the trimesters. See the table adjacent for more information.

Foundation and Diploma scholarships

We are offering a limited number of scholarships for our Foundation program and Diploma courses. Applicants will be assessed at the time of application and must commence their course of study in any of the trimesters. The Foundation program offers a 50% scholarship, and the Diploma offers a 25% scholarship.

MBA scholarships

We are offering a limited number of 20% scholarships for the Master of Business Administration. Applicants will be assessed at the time of application and may commence their program of study in any of the trimesters.

Academic merit scholarship for current students

A 100% university scholarship is awarded each trimester on full tuition fees for up to 12 credit points to a current Murdoch Dubai student who achieves the most outstanding results (minimum 85%). 

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Diploma	
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Our internationally-recognised pre-university Foundation program prepares you for entry into the first year of your chosen degree. It equips you with the academic skills and subject knowledge required for successful admission into an undergraduate degree of your choice.

The Foundation program bridges the gap between the qualifications students gain at high school and those needed to enter an undergraduate degree. Foundation students will study core units that prepare them for further undergraduate courses relevant to their discipline, while also having an opportunity to take elective units that interest them from a range of disciplines. Our Foundation program is TEQSA accredited and is internationally recognised as an Australian pathway certificate for entry into Diploma and undergraduate programs.

Graduate Certificate in Business Administration

Duration

4 months, 1 trimester full-time or 8 months, 2 trimesters part-time

The course can be completed in one semester or trimester of full-time study, or part-time equivalent. Graduate Certificate in Education (Instructional Leadership)

Duration

8 months, 2 trimesters part-time

Tuition Fee (AED)

25,000 for the entire course

The Graduate Major in Instructional Leadership examines theories of instruction, educational change and leadership and considers the practical application of research from these areas in the complex and dynamic world of education. Students will explore a diverse range of instructional methods, their correct application and the research which supports their use. In addition, students will examine approaches to leadership and educational change, processes for initiating, implementing and sustaining change, the role of professional learning, coaching and conferencing in supporting instructional change, leading with emotional intelligence, change agent and leadership styles.

The course has a strong emphasis on practice. Students will be required to critically analyse and reflect on the theories, principles and research presented in the course and assessments will provide supported opportunities for these to be applied in their current or intended future practice.

Graduate Certificate in Education (International Education)

Duration

This Major introduces the history and development of International Education as a field of study. It explores the conceptualisation of international mindedness and the trend to internationalise curriculum. It examines and critiques a range of international curriculum models and practices, and introduces the essential elements of the International Baccalaureate (IB) suite of programs: Primary Years Program, Middle Years Program, and Diploma Program.

Where it will take you

Graduates will be trained to work in international schools throughout the world including International Baccalaureate schools and those schools internationalising the curriculum.

Professional recognition

The Major in International Education in Graduate Certificate in Education and Master of Education has been authorised by the International Baccalaureate (IB). If taking this option, on completion, students will be eligible to receive an IB Certificate in Teaching and Learning or IB Advanced Certificate in Teaching and Learning Research.

Master of Education (Coursework)

Duration

2 years, 6 trimesters

Tuition Fee (AED)

75,000 for the entire course

This is a three semester/trimester coursework degree designed to provide the education profession and the community in general with leaders capable of addressing critical issues in educational practice, policy and research. It is designed for: teachers, educational administrators, and other professionals with educational roles and responsibilities in allied or related fields who seek to extend and deepen their expertise in Education seeking professional development and renewal; and those planning to proceed to the Doctor of Education.

Students undertake a research-based project of 6 points and 30 points of coursework. This is a coursework-classified course available in a combination of internal/external modes at the Murdoch campus and completed internally at the Murdoch University International Study Centre (Dubai, U.A.E).

Where it will take you

This course will provide you with the knowledge, understanding and skills required to enhance your teaching, leadership and/or administration roles within the education field.












Climate

Dubai is known for warm and sunny weather throughout the year, due to its latitude. There are two distinct seasons – summer and winter. Dubai summers are milder than most nearby Gulf cities due to its coastal location.

The winter season is typically considered to begin in October and last until April but temperatures remain pleasant and consistently suitable for a range of fun outdoor activities.

Culture and Customs

Dubai is a cosmopolitan city, a melting pot of diverse cultures and religious faiths. Whilst Islam is the official religion of the United Arab Emirates, Christian, Hindu, Sikh, Buddhist and other religious communities peacefully co-exist throughout the UAE.

Dubai is a very safe city and has consistently featured as one of the 10 safest cities in the world.

Language

Although Arabic is the official language of the UAE, English is the second most common language used due to the large expatriate community.

Dress Code

All attires and cultural preferences are generally acceptable. Swimwear is permissible on beaches, and for water based entertainment but is not considered appropriate in areas such as business districts and shopping malls. It is pertinent to note that in the more historical quarters of the city and places of religious worship, dressing conservatively is appreciated.

Restaurants and Night Life

The restaurants in Dubai are as diverse as the city's cultural fabric. You can dine out on almost any budget and experience a variety of food from across the globe. Outdoor dining is common in the cooler months, providing a pleasant atmosphere to catch up with friends.

Transportation

Dubai has an efficient and cost effective public transport system that connects the city. Students can take advantage of subsidized fares with a student Nol card.

Dubai Bus is fully operational from 4:00am to 1:00am (next day).

The Dubai Metro currently operates two lines, with trains running every few minutes between 5:00am - 12:00am. Taxis are also amongst the most frequently used form of transport in Dubai.

The transport timings may vary. Please refer to the official Road and Transport Authority (RTA) for further details.

Shopping

Dubai is known as an incredible shopping destination. The city is home to the world's largest shopping centre - Dubai Mall - where you will find a host of international brands, both luxury and high street.

For a different shopping experience, stroll through the marketplace-style souks or the bustling streets of Karama, where you'll find a wide range of goods and spices.

Most shopping malls are open between 10:00am – 10:00pm and there are several supermarkets operating 24 hours a day.

Cost of Living

The cost of living in Dubai will vary depending on where you live and other factors. Basic products and services are reasonably priced and there are regular sales and promotions on consumer goods. There is no tax on salaries in the UAE and Value Added Tax on commodities is very minimal. Students are also eliaible for special discounts to use public transport and access prominent sights like museums and other touristic attractions.

Given the lower cost of living in comparison to various other cities like London or Sydney, the UAE continues to attract top talent from across the world, allowing scope for better economic growth and innovation.

Average Monthly Expenses

The following comparison provides an estimate on the monthly costs associated with living in Dubai (USD 1 = AED 3.67).



It is mandatory for all students studying in the UAE to hold a valid student visa. Murdoch University Dubai provides UAE Student Visas through the Dubai Development Authority along with full support during the process.

Additional Information

UAE Student visas are valid for a period of 12 months and will be renewed at the end of each 12-month period.

Health Insurance

All international students in UAE must have health insurance for the duration of their visa. Please note that students will receive health insurance cover after the student has attended their medicals. An appointment will be scheduled and mediated by the visa office.

I. Entry Permit Your Entry Permit will be processed once you have met the conditions of your offer and the fees have been paid. The process normally takes between 15-20 working days.

2. Student Visa

Students inside the UAE:

The medical and biometrics will follow after the entry permit and changed status. The biometrics can be done only after an appointment is scheduled. The process will take 15-20 working days.

Students outside the UAE:

The medical and biometrics will follow after the student informs Student Services of their arrival with the entry permit. The biometrics can be done only after an appointment is scheduled. The process will take 15-20 working days.

3. Emirates ID card

Once your visa is granted, you will be issued with your Emirates ID card. The Emirates ID card is your legal documentation in UAE and must always be carried with you. The process normally takes between 4-5 working days, after the biometrics are done.




